child—children

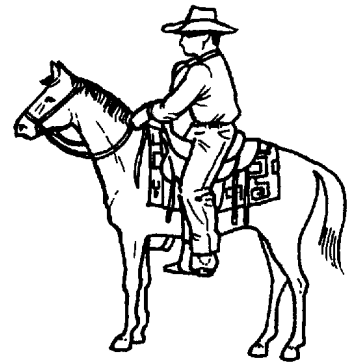
foot—feet
